Santa Monica Beach and Pier

Santa Monica Blvd. and Ocean Av. Santa Monica, CA

The Santa Monica Pier was built in the early 1900s. It continues to attract visitors to its carnival-type atmosphere which includes rides and games and hot dogs, too!

Route 66 ends a block away from the pier at the intersection of Santa Monica Blvd. and Ocean Avenue. The Will Rogers Highway Dedication Plaque is across the street from here in Palisades Park - the real end of Route 66.

Third Street Promenade:

Walking distance from the Pier, a three-block stretch of 3rd Street in Santa Monica has been sealed off from traffic, turning it into a pedestrian shopping and dining mecca. Among the popular clothing brand names are Abercrombie & Fitch, Adidas, Banana Republic, The Gap, J. Crew and Zara.
